All the above courses can be offered at HSW; which courses will be offered the next academic year depends on the options chosen by the recruited cohort.

General Entry Requirements

Students can choose between the following pathways:

- a) 2 Years of Study 3 Courses: At least 5 GCSEs at grades 9-4 (including English Language and Maths) and must meet the course specific GCSE grade requirements.
- b) 2 Years of Study 4 Courses: A minimum of 6 GCSEs grade 9-7 (including English Language and Maths) and must meet the course specific GCSE grade requirements.
- c) 3 Years of Study 3 Courses (with a Foundation year): This pathway is for students that do not meet the above criteria but would still like to progress to Sixth Form. Year 12 will be tailored to the students' individual needs, allowing them to achieve the required GCSE grades in order to study the courses of their choice the following year.

You must choose which pathway you are applying for and <u>5 potential courses</u> you are interested in. You can combine A-Level and BTEC courses. When choosing a BTEC course, you have to choose between Extended Certificate (Equivalent to 1 A-level) or Diploma (Equivalent to 2 A-levels).
